## Funding to Benefit Community Organizations

Nineteen Kindersley organizations will benefit from funding this year as the Town of Kindersley distributes its annual Kindersley Community Initiatives Program (KCIP) grant. A total of \$45,154 will be distributed in 2016. Funding for KCIP is provided by Saskatchewan Lotteries and is intended to encourage involvement in recreation, culture, and sports activities by addressing the needs of local residents.
