Council Establishes City Status Committee

Kindersley Town Council has established a Committee of Council specifically to research the benefits and implications of becoming Saskatchewan's next city by 2016.

The City Status Committee was approved during the November 24 Regular Meeting of Council, putting into motion planning that will determine the advantages, costs, and challenges of achieving city status and the most appropriate means upon which city status could be achieved for Kindersley.

The Committee will include members of Council and Town Administration and will involve consultation with other Saskatchewan communities that have recently obtained city status. Once all research material has been collected, a public meeting will be held to gain community feedback.

“We have seen tremendous growth in Kindersley and we are already recognized among other cities in Saskatchewan as having similar challenges regarding growth and infrastructure,” said Mayor John Enns-Wind.

“By taking a thorough, planned approach to city status and learning from the experiences of other communities, we are preparing Kindersley to be a successful city in the future without compromising the benefits and values that currently make us a great town.”

A report from the City Status Committee is expected by Council no later than May 2016 so that, if recommended, an application to the Province can be made for the Town of Kindersley to officially become a city in conjunction with the next municipal election in October 2016.
