That WHEREAS Town of Kindersley Bylaw No. 18-10, A Bylaw to Provide for the Care and Control of Animals and Bees, Section XIII – Bees, Livestock, Poultry, Exotic and Wild Animals, states in part:

(a) No person shall keep bees, livestock or poultry within the Town except for the following areas:

- (i) in a stockyard, where the same is a permitted use under the Zoning Bylaw, provided that all Federal and Provincial regulations relating to stockyards are complied with;
- (ii) or with special permission of Council;
- (iii) bees may be kept within the Town between September 15 and April 30 of each year.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Kindersley recognizes that Honey Bees are an important asset to the sustainability of agriculture and stability of our environment;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Council of the Town of Kindersley proclaims May 29, 2011 as the second annual "Day of the Honey Bee".
