

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KINDERSLEY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Kindersley is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting Kindersley; and

WHEREAS, new lightweight building materials burn quickly and many of today's products and furnishings produce toxic gases and smoke when burned, making it impossible to see and breathe within moments which contributes to a much smaller window of time for people to escape a home fire safely, with people having as little as one to two minutes to escape from the time the smoke alarm sounds; and

WHEREAS, a home fire escape plan provides the skill set and know-how for Kindersley residents to quickly and safely escape a home fire situation by including two exits from every room in the home; a path to the outside from each exit; smoke alarms in all required locations; and a meeting place outside where everyone in the home will meet upon exiting; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 Fire Prevention Week theme, "Every Second Counts: Plan 2 Ways Out!" effectively serves to educate the public about the vital importance of involving every member of the household in developing a home fire escape plan and practicing it twice a year; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Kindersley proudly supports the members of the Kindersley Fire Department as one of the most highly trained departments in the province, proficient in both fire-fighting and vehicle rescue techniques, and who are dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires and home fire injuries through prevention and protection education; and

THEREFORE, I Rod Perkins, Mayor of the Town of Kindersley do hereby proclaim October 8 to 14, 2017, as Fire Prevention Week throughout this community; and

THAT the Council of the Town of Kindersley urges all the people of Kindersley to develop a home fire escape plan with all members of the household and practice it twice a year; and

THAT everyone is urged to participate in the Kindersley Fire Department, RCMP, and EMS open house to be held October 14, 2017 from 11AM to 3PM in the Kindersley Walmart parking lot.
