POLICY

- The Food Bank is available to those in the Kindersley and surrounding area who require food supplies.
- Accessing a Food Bank does not affect or reduce any other benefits or assistance now being received.
- The application must be signed by Clergy or other professional who can speak on the applicants behalf. All information is held in the strictest of confidence.
- 4. Every application must be completely filled out and signed by the referring person.
- 5. Applications for a food hamper must be returned by the 15th of the month

Procedure

The Food Bank is located behind Premier Dance at 110B Railway Avenue East (Back entrance).

- Application forms are available from Spokes
 Family Resource Centre (located at Brethren in
 Christ Church) 819 Main Street and the
 Salvation Army and <u>must</u> be returned on or
 before the 15th of the month. Health
 Numbers are required.
- Application forms can be filled in by the family or the individual requesting food supplies and <u>must</u> be returned to the referring person for signature. The referring person must be able to speak on the behalf of the recipient.
- 3. Hamper pick-up times are from

9:30 AM-NOON & 4:30 PM-6:30 PM

- 4. All hampers must be applied for on a monthly basis.
- Emergency food hampers can be filled in special circumstances. Call the Food Bank at 306-460-7022 for more information.
- Verbal and or physical abuse will not be tolerated on the premises.
