WHEREAS, prostate cancer is the most common cancer to affect Canadian men; and WHEREAS, 1 in 8 Canadian men will be diagnosed with the disease in his lifetime; and WHEREAS, an estimated 24,000 Canadian men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer this year; and WHEREAS, the survival rate for prostate cancer can be over 90% when detected early; and WHEREAS, those with a family history of the disease, or those of African or Caribbean descent, are at a greater risk of developing prostate cancer; and WHEREAS, Prostate Cancer Canada recommends that men get a PSA test in their 40's to establish their baseline; THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Kindersley, Saskatchewan, do hereby proclaim September 2015 as Prostate Cancer Awareness Month in Kindersley.
